### STATIONARY SEATING POLICY

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#### **Purpose**

To provide reserved seating, where possible, for those players suffering from a chronic or temporary medical condition that causes mobility issues.

#### **Policy Statement**

Members and Non Members must apply to the Management Committee for the right to a stationary seat. All applications must be accompanied by a current medical certificate or letter from a registered and currently practising General Practitioner or Specialist, on their practice letterhead, stating the nature of the condition and the length of time this condition may extend.

All Members 90 years of age and over are automatically entitled to a stationary seat.

Members with stationary seating are expected to:

- Be seated, or make the Director aware of their presence, at least twenty minutes prior to the commencement of the session.
- Let the Director know of their absence if they are not coming to play using the contact details below.
